To be a member of the DREAM TEAM, students are recommended by their teachers, coaches, and DREAM TEAM advisors. The DREAM TEAM is composed of athletes from multiple sports **with an emphasis on those who play more than one sport**. In order to be on the DREAM TEAM, and remain on the DREAM TEAM, a student-athlete:

- Must have a 3.3 grade point average. (Minimum---higher grade point average +)
- Must be recommended, apply and be **selected annually**.
- Must be academically successful in the classroom, and attend classes regularly.
- Must realize OSS assignments, office referrals, ejections from athletic competitions, excessive
  tardies, failure to attend team activities and absences may result in loss of DREAM TEAM status
  or prevent you from being appointed to the team.
- Must abide by the NWHS ATOD/social media policies (alcohol, tobacco, other drugs).
- Must apply to be on the DREAM TEAM if recommended.
- Must participate in scheduled DREAM TEAM activities
- You will be selected based on the sport/coach you played for this past season, if you are not planning on participating in those sports, any one of them, you must note it on the data sheet. It may affect your DREAM TEAM status.

If you quit a team or are dismissed from a team, you may be removed from the DREAM TEAM or be dropped from consideration for the upcoming year. You may be eligible to return to the DREAM TEAM in future years.

- 5. The office checks the list against discipline referrals. OSS, ISS and detention can impact your selection.
- 6. You must fill out an application, return it on time and complete the interview process.
- 7. Once all data is collected, applicants are rank ordered and the selection is made.
- 8. If you quit a sport during the nomination year, you will not be considered for the upcoming year.
- 9. The Dream Team is composed of sophomores, juniors and seniors with every effort made to balance the team between grade levels and sports. Priority is given to those who play multiple sports but a one sport athlete can make the team if they are the only representative nominated for that sport. Members are selected and notified during the summer after final grades are posted.
- 10. A mandatory training session will be held during the week prior to the first week of school. This is required. You must attend the training to be on the Dream Team.
- 11. Dream Team appointments are for one year. You may or may not be reappointed for the following year based on how you score in the evaluation process.
